My dear Parishioners,

First of all, I would like to welcome wholeheartedly the new members of our Church. There were five baptisms of adults at the Easter Vigil ceremony, and this was a real blessing for all of us. We also will have the First Communion of eight adults on May 26, and seventeen adults will be confirmed on June 01. All these people are loved by our community.

In this Sunday's Gospel we have the question: "Peter, do you love me?" It was to Peter that Jesus made this question, and he repeats it three times. Peter became quite sad because it seemed that Jesus did not trust Peter's answer. But there was a reason for Jesus asking Peter three times. It was necessary to have certitude that Peter was prepared for what Jesus was about to ask of him. "Therefore, feed my sheep."

The love of God is connected with the feeding of his sheep, in making sure that they don't remain alone at the mercy of the wolves. He who loves, takes care. Jesus seems worried about the care that some sheep might receive. No sheep can be abandoned because all are dearly loved by God.

Jesus asks us the same question today. If we love Jesus we will take care of his sheep, especially the most needy. This is important for the Kingdom. Sometimes we get involved in some details of our Church that are not essential. We risk taking the focus off of where we should be working. Everything in our Church must be for the common good of our brothers and sisters, for their spiritual health, while the material side, the building, the beauty of the church, the

wonderful celebrations, all have a part in this, but the more important must be acquired. Our welcoming spirit, our closeness to the other, making the other understand that God loves him or her infinitely, and that he takes care of us with unconditional love. This love should lead us to social caring, to the necessities of the Church and the poor, to the undocumented immigrants, to those in jail, to those who don't participate in our banquets and holidays.

Answer Jesus' question in your heart. Love Jesus, and feed his sheep with tenderness. I am certain that the reward in heaven will be immense.
